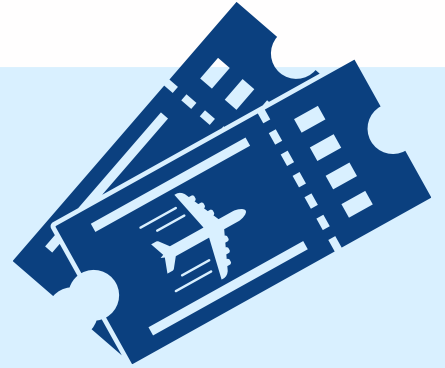

CHECK IN PROCESS FOR

American Airlines GROUP FLIGHTS!

The group leader will receive a record locator for the entire group! You will present this record locator, also known as a confirmation number, to the American Airlines Agent upon your arrival to the airport.

We recommend arriving to the airport 2 hours before your departure time to ensure time for the check in process, security, finding your gate, and to purchase any last minute items you may want to bring on the plane with you. (*Snacks, ear buds, water, etc.*)

3

Each traveler is permitted one carry on item and one personal item. A carry on item for American Airlines should not exceed 8 inches X 14 inches X 18 inches and should not contain liquids or creams larger than 3.6 oz. A personal item is something that will fit under the seat in front of you! Travelers can check bags while the group checks in for an additional \$40 (Rate is subject to change based on airline's discretion).

Please keep in mind any travelers under the age of 18 will not need to present any form of ID. Travelers 18 years of age or older will need to present an ID.

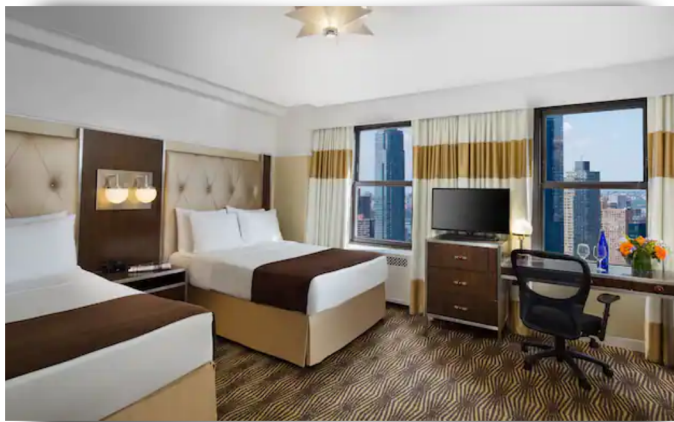
